The organisers decided that this edition will be in honour of the late “Sir Nour-Eddine Saïl”, who was a Moroccan pioneer in the determination of film culture in the kingdom, paying homage to his great critical contributions in the field of cinema. The festival administration, therefore, will be receiving films wishing to be nominated in the official competition category (professional and amateur films contest). The deadline to receive films is scheduled for the end of June 2021.

The application must include:

- Filmmaker's photo identity
- Autobiography written in Arabic and English, not exceeding four lines
- Film poster and its summary is written in Arabic and English, not exceeding three lines
- A brief message addressed to the President of the association allowing, if selected, the screening of the film, among the official competition of the festival.
- All works submitted must require high-quality standards at the level of picture and sound.
- Film duration is not specified
- Films produced in 2019-2020-2021 are accepted.

Selected films will compete for several awards and will be determined in a special announcement, with members of the jury panels, together with numerous publication announcements regarding all activities and other details associated with this edition.
